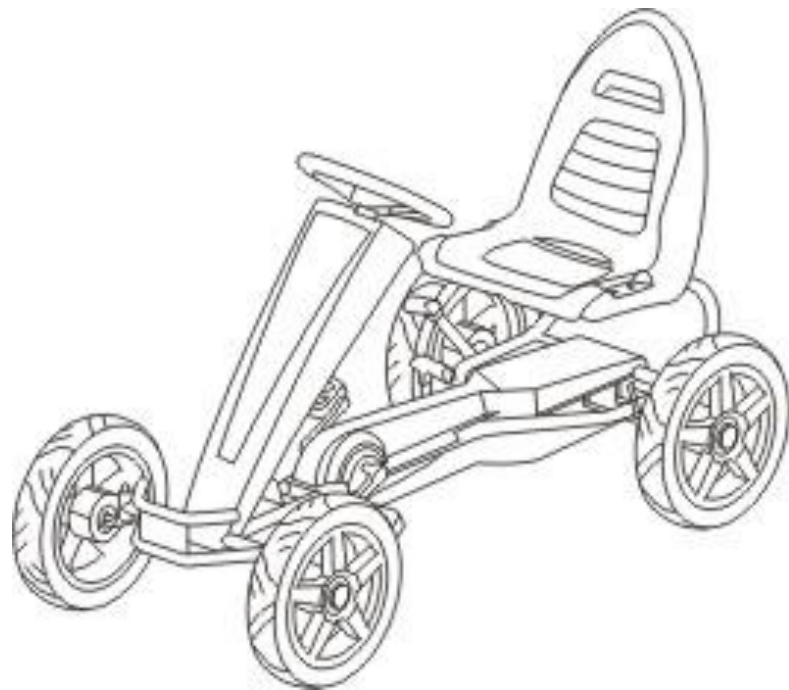

I. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



1. use the screwdriver to link the front car frame and rear car frame together



2. Pass the steering shaft through the frame and fix it with front car frame.



3. Fix the liner tube to the front car frame



4. Fit the steering wheel on the steering column and fix it with screw 5*35.



5. Fix seat with 5*45 screws.



6. Fix the top of front panel and fix it with screw 4*10

II. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

- A. The product must be assembled and checked by an adult before use.
- B. To be used under the direct supervision of an adult.
- C. Appropriate protective equipment such as a helmet should be worn at all times.
- D. This product is only suitable for children aged 5 to 12 years.
- E. The maximum safe load is 50kg.
- F. Where adjustable, make sure that the seat is set to the right position in relation to the pedals.
- G. This product must not be ridden on public highways, slopes, besides swimming pool or any areas considered hazardous.
- H. Considerable speeds can be achieved when going downhill, so remember that this makes the braking distance longer.
- I. Do not reverse at high speed.
- J. Drive at the appropriate speed, depending on the situation.
- K. Do not take sharp bends at high speed.
- L. Always use the brake to slow down.
- M. Avoid wearing loose or trailing clothing or dangling shoelaces. These can get caught in moving parts and cause an accident.
- N. Do not get on or off the vehicle when it is moving.
- O. Do not place any unnecessary object over the brake or steering.
- P. Do not ride in the dark without lights.
- Q. Always pay attention to what is going on around you.
- R. Do not drive under the influence of medication that may have an effect on your ability to observe what is going on around you.
- S. Make sure that the steering and brake work properly before use.
- T. Check fixings and moving parts before each use.
